## Capitol **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed about 1945  
The Capitol had 464 seats

## Caprice **OPEN**

404 Duncan St  
Opened about 1985  
Caprice Entertainment owned the Caprice.

Cinema 1 672 seats  
Cinema 2 293 seats  
Total 965 seats

## Cowichan **CLOSED**

Opened about 1985 and closed about 1990

## Duncan Park Drive-In

### **CLOSED**

Opened about 1970 and closed about 1975  
WCTS owned the drive-in, which had space for 305 cars.

## Odeon **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed about 1975  
Odeon owned the Odeon, which had 449 seats and 722 seats in 1944 and 499 in 1970

## Odeon Park **CLOSED**

Opened about 1980 and closed about 1980  
Odeon owned the Odeon Park, which had 576 seats

## Sunset Drive-In **CLOSED**

Opened about 1955 and closed about 1955  
Sunset Auto Theatres Limited owned the drive-in, which had space for 400 cars.

## CHEMAINUS

### Caprice **CLOSED**

? 1975-? 1980  
T. L. Weir owned this theatre.

### Willow **CLOSED**

? 1950-? 1965  
This theatre had 406 seats and it was owned by:  
? 1950 Chemainus Theatre Ltd. who opened it 4 days a week,  
? 1960 P. T. Horpe-Doodle who opened it 3 days a week,  
? 1965 A & M Carmichael.
