Opened about 1955 and the last

season in 2003, this drive-in has

been demolished for an Wal-Mart.

Auto-Vue Drive-In Limited and in

which has space for 400 cars.



Liberty **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and renamed

Strand about 1935

The Liberty had 515 seats.

Odeon **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed

about 1965

Odeon owned the Odeon, which had

610 seats.

Rialto **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed

about 1945

The Rialto had 522 seats.

Rio **CLOSED**

Opened about 1945 and closed

about 1945

The Rio had 449 seats.
