Listowel Drive-In **CLOSED**

AKA: Llashmar Drive-In

Cecil R. Pelton owned this drive-in,
which had space for 300 cars

Llashmar Drive-In **CLOSED**

AKA: Listowel Drive-In

R. L. Marshall owned this drive-in,
which had space for 300 cars.

ST. MARY'S

Lyric **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed
about 1960

The Lyric theatre had 431 seats and it
was owned by: 1950 H. J.

Sutherland, 1960 C. Stanyon who
opened it 3 days a week

STRATFORD

Avon **CLOSED**

Opened about 1945 and closed
about 1965

The Avon theatre had 999 seats and
it was owned by: 1950 Premier, 1965
Stratford Festival.

Classic **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed
about 1950

The Classic theatre had 512 seats
and it was owned by premier

Majestic **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed
about 1940

The Majestic theatre had 1209 seats.

Vogue **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed
about 1990

The Vogue was owned by Premier
and in about 1990 Woodstock
amusements, which had 704 seats

Stratford Drive-In **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed
about 1995

This drive-in had space for 350 cars
and it was owned by: 1950 Stratford
Drive-In Ltd, 1955 A. I. Rosenburg,
1970 Club Montreal Co. Ltd, 1975
Premier
