Opened about 1955 and closed about 1960
The Lize theatre had 500 seats and it was owned by: 1950 Henry Lodge, 1960 Gaston Theroux

DANVILLE

Magnet **CLOSED**

Opened about 1945 and closed about 1950
The Magnet theatre had 230 seats and it was owned by Alfred Fortier

Town Hall **CLOSED**

Opened about 1955 and closed about 1955
Alfred Fortier managed the Town Hall theatre, which had 230 seats and opened 2 days a week

MRC COATICOOK COATICOOK

Opera House **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed about 1980
The Opera House had 467 seats and it was owned by: 1950 Y. Blouin, 1955 Leo Poin, 1960 Henri Masse, 1980 M.M. Laroche

Rivoli **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed about 1955
The Rivoli theatre had 250 seats and it was owned by: 1950 J. L. Charbonneau, 1955 R. Berzan

MRC L'AMIANTE EAST BROUGHTON

Perro **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed about 1980
The Perro theatre had 250 seats and it was owned by: 1950 J. P. Perrault, 1980 M. R. Tardiff

MRC LE HAUT-SAINT-FRANÇOIS EAST ANGUS

Eden **CLOSED**

Opened about 1965 and closed about 1970
The Eden theatre had 350 seats and it was owned by P. Papuin and H. Masse

Royal **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed about 1960
The Royal theatre had 200 seats and it was owned by R. Martin.

Salle Paroissiale **CLOSED**

? 1950

E. Turgeon shown movies once a week in this 125-seat hall.

SCOTSTOWN

Scotstown **CLOSED**

? 1960-? 1970

E. Turcotte owned this 400-seat theatre.

WEEDON

Imperial **CLOSED**

Mrs. P. Bourget owned this 300-seat theatre.

Rio **CLOSED**

? 1955, ? 1975-? 1985

This theatre had 300 seats and was owned in about 1955 by P. H. Bourget and in about 1975 by Clermont Palardy

Weedon **CLOSED**

? 1960-? 1970

E. Tardif owned this 200-seat theatre, which was opened 4 days a week.

WINDSOR

Caro **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed about 1950
The Caro theatre had 450 seats and it was owned by E. Poirier

Loma **CLOSED**

Opened about 1950 and closed about 1975
The Loma theatre had 450 seats and it was owned by: 1950 J. E. Lemieux and R. Noel, 1975 M. R. Tardif.

MRC VAL-SAINT-FRANÇOIS RICHMOND

Myra **CLOSED**

Opened about 1945 and closed about 1965
The Myra theatre had 300 seats and it was owned by: 1950 M. F. Lodge, 1960 A. Babin, 1965 L. Raymond

Richmond **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed about 1940
The Richmond theatre had 250 seats.

MRC MEMPHRÉMAGOG MAGOG

Capitol **CLOSED**

Opened about 1940 and closed about 1950
The Capitol theatre had 378 seats and it was owned by Leo Choquette

Cartier **CLOSED**

Opened about 1960 and closed about 1960
Leo Choquette owned the Cartier theatre, which had 400 seats.

Centre **CLOSED**

Opened about 1955 and closed about 1970
The Centre theatre had 350 seats and it was owned by: 1955 L. Goudreault, 1965 Real Joyal, 1970 Remi St. Martin

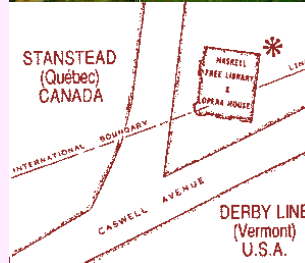

Premier **CLOSED**

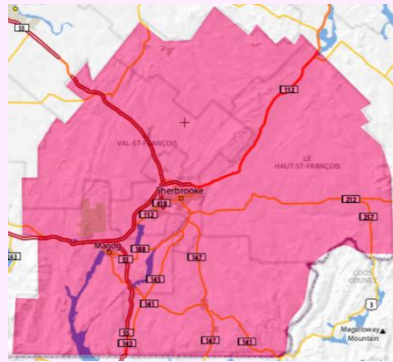
AKA: Premier, Capri, Maison du Cinema
