### Twilite Drive-In **CLOSED**

?1955-?2000

This 140-car drive-in was owned by ?1955 V. Wouters, ?2000 L. Slaboda

### Unity **CLOSED**

?1995

Kevin Akerlund owned this theatre.

## WILKIE

### Marnell **CLOSED**

Opened about 1935 and closed about 1935

The Marnell theatre had 350 seats.

### Roxy **CLOSED**

Opened about 1940 and closed about 1970 reopened about 1980 and closed about 1980

The Roxy theatre had 400 seats and it was owned by: 1950 Rothstein theatres, 1970 Elizabeth Fontine, 1980 Community Development Corporation.

### Circus Drive-In **CLOSED**

Opened about 1955 and closed about 1960

This Drive-In had space for 388 cars and M. Friedman and Associates owned it.
