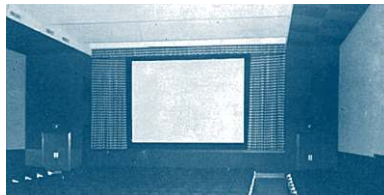
### Cinema **OPEN**
