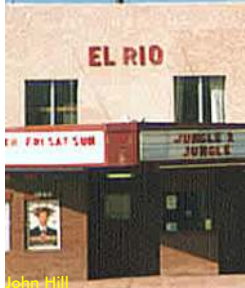

Winslow **OPEN**

AKA: Rialto
2002-
The theatre opened in about 1927 and
seats about 700. It presented movies
along with live stage acts. The
Nace/Rickards chain owned it. It had a
Meisel & Sullivan pipe organ, which was
still occasionally used until 1950s.
There was a major fire in the theatre
about 1955 and theatre underwent major
remodeling and operated sporadically
until about the mid-1980s. It sat boarded
up with its marquee removed until about
two years ago when Allen Afeldt who
owns the La Posada historic hotel in
Winslow bought it and reopened it.

Presently showing films and plans to
eventually add live music performances
and community activities.
